### May 22 - 23

On arrival at Kigali International Airport you'll be met by your airside representative at the arrivals hall entrance. They will assist you with immigration before guiding you to the VIP lounge while you relax and enjoy a complimentary drink and something to eat should you wish.

## May 24 - 26

o6hoo an early rise and excitedly head out onto the plains that sit below Karenge camp. Because you're in the north of the park, you'll have the plains to yourself which will provide some of the best game viewing in Akagera.

On return, grab some lunch back at Camp before heading out again for another game drive, this time south towards the next camp, Ruzizi Tented Camp.

## May 23 - 24 | Kigali Genocide Memorial

## A place of remembrance and learning

The Kigali Genocide Memorial is the final resting place for more than 250,000 victims of the 1994 genocide against the Tutsi.

The Kigali Genocide Memorial includes three permanent exhibitions. The largest one documents the 1994 Genocide against the Tutsi and gives an outline of Rwandan society before colonisation, the horrors of the genocide, as well as stories of survival and rescue. There is also a children's memorial and an exhibition on the history of genocidal violence around the world. Outside, visitors can walk around the mass graves, visit the wall of names, and find a quiet place in the gardens of reflection.

The Memorial hosts a range of remembrance events and activities throughout the year, many of which occur during the annual commemoration period, from April 7 to July 4, in honor of the three months that the Genocide against the Tutsi lasted.

The Kigali Genocide Memorial is a guided experience. Visitors can choose between a guided tour by one of the staff witnesses or purchase the KGM digital guide and follow an audio-visual tour of the memorial.

A tour of the entire memorial takes approximately one hour and thirty minutes.



## May 23 - 24 | Karenge Bush Camp



### Property Overview

Karenge means 'small footprint' in Kinyarwanda, and is the name of the area where the camp was first established. The word also represents Karenge Bush Camp's commitment to leaving nothing more than a light ecological footprint. The camp is open 11 months of the year, only closing in April. Karenge contains six canvas tents and accommodates a maximum of 12 guests, making it an intimate wilderness experience. Rates do not include transport, park entry fees, activities, gratuities, and drinks. All meals are included.

### Experience & Activities

Akagera National Park has an inspiring conservation story as it is now home to lions and rhinos and is the only Big Five park in the country. For one park, the diversity of habitats is unique including lakes, marshes, savannah, mountains, and woodland. Akagera offers a variety of tourism activities, including game drives, boat trips, behind-the-scenes' park tours, guided walks, and community cultural experiences. It is also a birder's delight, with more than 482 bird species documented, including the rare and prehistoric shoebill.

Every tent has two camp beds, camp chairs, reed mat floors, and solar lights. The camp's six tents have private outdoor bathrooms with bucket showers, toilets, and canvas basins. Warm water is provided daily.

# May 24 - 26 | Akagera National Park



### Area Overview

Akagera National Park offers a truly exceptional wildlife experience. It is the only Big Five reserve in Rwanda and is also home to the rare swamp-dwelling Sitatunga. The Park has a unique diversity of habitats, including lakes, marshes, savannah, mountains, and woodland, and is the largest protected wetland in central Africa. Despite being a relatively small park at just 1,122 km², it is home to an impressive array of wildlife.

Guests have the opportunity to see an abundance of birdlife, including the rare Shoebill stork, the endangered papyrus Gonolex, and the much sought-after Red-faced Barbet. With over 500 recorded species, Akagera is one of the best birding environs in the world, with the highest recorded number of species per unit area.



## May 24 - 26 | Ruzizi Tented Lodge



## Property Overview

Ruzizi is an eco-lodge located on the banks of Lake Ihema in Akagera National Park. Its nine tents are set back from Ihema's serene shores and hidden among swaying palms and fruiting fig trees. They flank a thatched reception and dining area, and wooden walkways lead to a stunning deck that hangs over the lake.

The lodge was designed to blend in with its surroundings to ensure guests connect with nature. During construction, trees and vegetation were left undisturbed when possible. Some natural elements have been incorporated into the structure, and many of Ruzizi's decorations and furniture were hand-crafted by local artisans and cooperatives. The lodge is powered by solar energy and prides itself on being environmentally conscious.

### Experience & Activities

Akagera National Park offers a variety of tourism activities. Travellers seeking a variation on the typical safari should consider a boat trip on Lake Ihema, where you can drift along the forest-fringed body of water in the midst of hippos and crocodiles. Spend a relaxing day fishing from the shores of the lake. For additional insights into Akagera, take a 'behind-the-scenes' tour of park headquarters, where you'll meet employees integral to park management while learning about exciting conservation developments.

A boat trip on Lake Ihema is wildlife and bird viewing from a different point of view with four daily scheduled trips. Guided night safari drives are also available for guests. The sunset departure is an ideal way to end your day and the best way to see nocturnal wildlife. Or enjoy a walking safari with experienced guides, getting close to nature's intricate details, while experiencing Akagera's vast picturesque landscapes.

## May 27 - 28 | Lake Kivu



#### Area Overview

Lake Kivu, situated on the border between Rwanda and the Democratic Republic of the Congo, is a freshwater lake nestled within the Albertine Rift. The region is characterized by a combination of rolling hills, picturesque shorelines, and the expansive freshwater body that stretches across the East African Rift Valley. The lake is surrounded by lush greenery and terraced fields, and its waters often reflect the surrounding hills that frame it; these hills are part of the larger Virunga mountain range, adding to the dramatic and varied topography of the region.

Biodiversity thrives in and around Lake Kivu, contributing to the ecological richness of the area. The lake is home to a diverse array of fish species, including tilapia and various types of cichlids. Fishermen dot the shores, utilizing traditional fishing methods that have been passed down through generations.

## Property Overview

Lake Kivu Serena Hotel is located in the resort Rwandan town of Gisenyi, on the shores of Lake Kivu, the sixth largest lake in Africa. # May 28 - 30 | Volcanoes National Park



### Area Overview

Just a three hour drive from Kigali, Volcanoes National Park encompasses 160 km² (60mi²) in a rich mosaic of montane ecosystems, with evergreen and bamboo forests. The national park includes five of the eight volcanoes in the Virunga Mountains, with Karisimbi being the highest at 4,507 m (14,785 ft). The lush slopes of these volcanoes provide a dramatic natural setting for one of the most thrilling and memorable wildlife experiences: seeing the mountain gorilla in its natural habitat. Roughly half of the world's wild population of mountain gorillas reside on the Rwandan slopes of the Virungas massif.

This is also the setting for the film *Gorillas in the Mist*, an autobiography about Diane Fossey, who set up the Karisoke Research Center and dedicated her life to these wonderful animals.

## May 29 | Gorilla Trekking

### Activity overview

The Virunga Mountains straddle the borders of Rwanda, Uganda, and the Democratic Republic of Congo, and are home to around 480 mountain gorillas, more than half of the world's entire population — the rest live in Uganda's Bwindi Impenetrable Forest.

In Volcanoes National Park, which encompasses five of the eight volcanoes in the Virunga Mountains, twelve gorilla groups are now habituated for tourism and offer one of the world's most awe-inspiring natural experiences. To be in the presence of these gentle giants at such close quarters is truly a once in a lifetime experience.

Although the immense size of the silverbacks might be overwhelming, these 400-pound creatures are actually extremely accommodating to human presence amongst their family. The guides might even teach you a few words in 'Gorilla' so you can greet them and show that you are, in fact, friendly!

The day of the trek usually begins with an early start at your hotel and then a drive to park headquarters at Kinigi. Here, park officials assign you to a gorilla family and you meet your gorilla guides. After being briefed on protocols, you head over to the specific starting point, where teams of porters are available for hire. Remember, you are trekking for around 2,500m and so any help is welcome.

Groups are limited to eight guests. The initial trek is usually through rural Rwanda's open fields of potatoes and pyrethrum, until you reach the rough wall boundary of the park itself. From here, your guide will be in communication with the trackers and you will begin the hike through the forest to meet the gorillas. Your permit allows you one hour with the gorilla family, after which you say goodbye to your trackers and hike back down to meet your awaiting vehicle.

## Booking Terms

### 1. DEPOSIT, PAYMENT & CANCELLATION DEPOSITS

A minimum deposit (price quoted above) is required upon booking to secure accommodation, transport & activity elements.

A 100% non-refundable payment is required for gorilla trekking permits. Remaining balances for any journey will become due 60 days prior to travel.

#### 2. CANCELLATIONS

Cancellations received more than 90 days before arrival will forfeit the deposit. Cancellations received between 90 and 60 days prior to arrival will forfeit 50% of trip payment. Cancellations received less than 60 days prior to arrival will forfeit 100% of trip payment.

No-shows or early departures will forfeit 100% of trip payment.

If a date change is required for Gorilla permits, a fee of \$300 per permit will be levied to facilitate any change. Permits are non refundable and non transferable. Please ensure you have adequate travel insurance in place prior to booking your tour. Cancellations and booking amendments must be received in writing and must be acknowledged by Barbara Edie in return.

### 3. INSURANCE

Travel insurance is mandatory for this trip. This insurance should have adequate medical, cancellation, curtailment and default insurance for the entirety of your trip. #### 6. GORILLA PERMITS

Gorilla Permits are issued solely by RDB (Rwanda Development Board), who also manage the Volcanoes National Park.

There are a restricted number of permits available each day and these are sold on a first come first serve basis. Permits can only be confirmed or held on receipt of full payment at RDB, with full names and passport information attached. The minimum age to embark on a gorilla trek is 15 years old, with no exceptions.

Gorilla permits are non-refundable and non-transferable once purchased. Trekking date can be altered once, at a fee of \$300 per permit. It is therefore essential to ensure adequate insurance is in place prior to booking and paying for permits.
